## November 13, 2015: Finishing Tips and Techniques with Bill Robillard

Guild members will recall that Bill gave us an outstanding program about glues and adhesives in April of 2014. When I approached Bill to give us a program this year he suggested that he talk about "finishing tips and techniques"

I took the opportunity to ask him about a specialized finish repair question that I had about matching stain color. His answer was something I had never thought of but was so obvious that I thought why didn't I think of that! I am sure the upcoming program will be chock full of valuable ideas.

Bill will discuss finishing tips and techniques such as selecting the proper brush for the job, correct sanding methods, laying down smooth varnish, and more. He will also discuss common finishing mistakes and some ways to avoid them.

Bill Robillard is a professional antique conservator and restorer and has been in business since 2009. Bill is a graduate of the National Institute of Wood Finishing and has worked at the U.S. Capitol and for the U.S. Congressional restoration shop. Bill's local clients include the Neville public museum.


