Rob Martens will give a demonstration on how he laminates curved wood parts, or “bents” for his projects. The presentation will include an illustrated process for making bents for projects. He will also show examples of some of the curved furniture pieces he has constructed.

Rob has a Masters Degree in Architecture and has designed many exemplary projects incorporating various kinds of wood and design. He was also featured in the Green Bay Press-Gazette, interviewed by Warren Gerds, and also featured on television.

Rob has recently started his own company, Innovative Architectural Creations LLC, and has just completed a Chapel project for the Catholic Diocese.

Please fill it out and return it as soon as possible or bring it to the January 17th meeting. All my addresses are on it. Fill out the form completely!!! It makes my life tolerable if all the info is on one sheet. I need to know the style and kind of wood in your raffle prize, not just "bowl." Thank You. If you are capable, send it electronically.

SET UP: We can again set up on Friday March 21 between 1PM & 4PM, possibly earlier. The remainder of you must set up Saturday morning at 7AM (not earlier) and must be done when the doors open at 9:30 AM.

DISPLAY TABLES: Every member is entitled to one table/floor space for display. As space permits (last year we ran out of space and expanded into the hallway) you may have 2 tables. Will you be demonstrating a wood-working skill??? I hope you can all sell or buy at least \$25 worth of tickets to cover some of our costs and can donate a raffle prize. We also need you to work the show even if you don't have a table. We need staffing at the raffle table, security, **clean up and** prize delivery.

RAFFLE TICKETS: I probably won't have raffle tickets available at the February meeting. You will be asked to take at least 4 or 5 books (\$20-25) to buy or sell, along with large posters and smaller handouts.

In the past we have crammed the prize name and sponsors of all the tool prizes in tiny print on each ticket. Not sure anyone could or did read them to the point that it was the deciding factor in buying the ticket. We will probably be less specific this year. You will be notified of the prizes as they become available either in next months newsletter or on the web site. Send as soon as possible (OK to bring to January meeting.) any details you have about the prize you will donate, and/or a picture, All sponsor donations will be honored at the show and in publications before and after the show. If you have any leads on a great prize call me ASAP. Please and thank you.

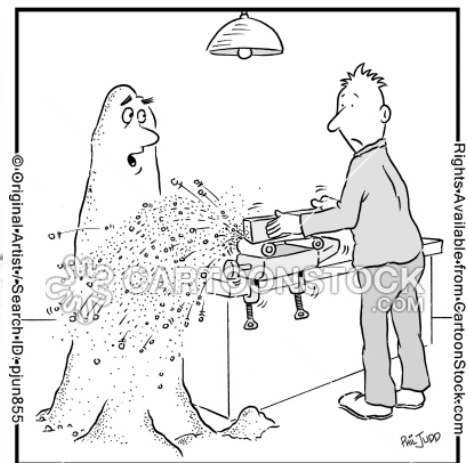

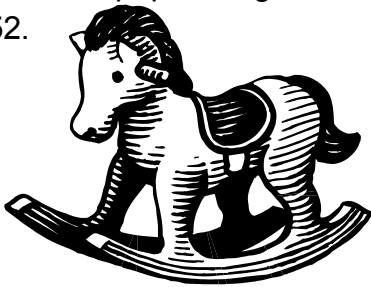

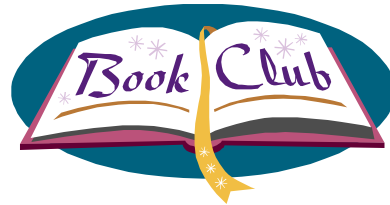
