The program will include how long we have built wagons, sleds, cutters, and have done repairs to fire engines, water wagons, cannons, grain drills, and a variety of other equipment. Also included will be what wood is used, how it is put together, and some finishes used. We will have photo showing how and why wheels are pitched/angled for strength, tools used, and names of pieces in vehicles. We will bring some tools and pieces with us to demonstrate.

1#	bacon	1/3 cup	flour
2/3 cup	vinegar	1 cup	chopped celery
1 & 1/2 cup	granulated Sugar	1 Tbsp.	Salt
1 cup	water	1 lg.	Onion, chopped

Pre boil to just tender, 5 # russet potatoes. Can do the day before & cool.

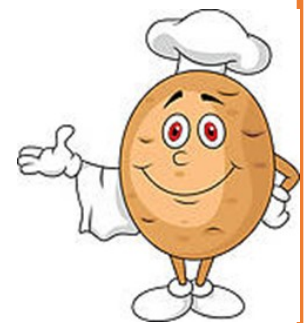
Peel the skins off and slice them in half and about 1/8" thick. Set aside.

Cut the bacon in 1 inch pieces, and fry to golden brown. Drain almost all of the grease off.

To the bacon in the pan, add the flour and stir well. Add all the remaining liquid and stir to a soft bubbling. Then add sugar, salt, celery, onion and stir altogether. Stir the pre-cooked potatoes to the bacon/sugar mix.
