NORWEGIAN BENTWOOD BOXES

with LARRY HLADILEK

A couple of decades ago, my wife Ann and I started taking classes in Norwegian Rose-maling. Loosely defined, rosemaling is decorative painting on wood. Being a woodworker I made the items to be decorated.. Of those items the traditional Norwegian Bentwood Box is the most interesting and challenging to make.

The presentation will be made in two parts: The first part will discuss the unique design of the box. The second part will investigate the materials and processes used to make any style of bentwood box.

Although the bentwood box is on it's own interesting, I view the presentation as an opportunity to lead a discussion on the “tricks of the trade” with respect to resawing veneer and bending wood. I invite all guild members to share your ideas and bentwood projects.

We will not have a library in December so bring back everything that is due and check out some good reading or videos for over the holidays.

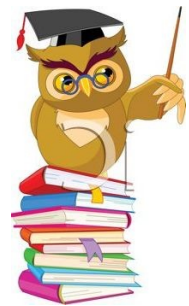
