Bill is the owner of Encore Restorations - an antique restoration company. Bill has done commission work for a number of high profile clients, including the U.S. House of Representatives and the U.S. Capitol. Last fall, Bill was part of the team that restored the Dias (on the U.S. House floor) from which the President addresses the nation. Bill's work has been featured in the Press Gazette as well as on Channel 5 news.

If you're still using that same old bottle of glue, this presentation may be for you. As a professional furniture restorer, Bill makes a living dealing with issues such as glue failure. Bill will make the case that selecting the correct adhesive, for your project, may be just as important as selecting the right kind of wood. Bill will review the various adhesives available today and some forgotten adhesives from the past. Selecting the right clamp will also be discussed.




