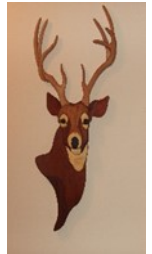
Northeastern Wisconsin Woodworkers Guild September Meeting

AUGUST PICNIC IN REVIEW

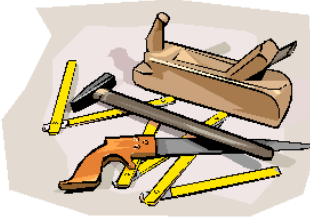
We want to thank everyone who came to our Woodworkers Guild Picnic on the 11th. The array of food was delicious! A good time was had by all and lots of friends were made.

We would need a few volunteers for some afternoon in late September or early October. We would need to remove the old planks, and shovel some of the dirt before replacing the planks with new.

The materials needed would be:

Treated Lumber:

2 x10 x 12	8 ea	4 x 4 x 12	1 ea	2 x 4 x10	6 ea
2 x 10 x 10	4 ea	2 x 4 x12	2 ea	deck material for seats 12'	5 ea

Screws: 4", about 200; screws for the seats 2" about 100

Chop saw, skill saw, 2 ea drill motors to drive screws, square, tape measure

A few shovels and extension cords.

This is something we could do as a club, to give back to the community.
