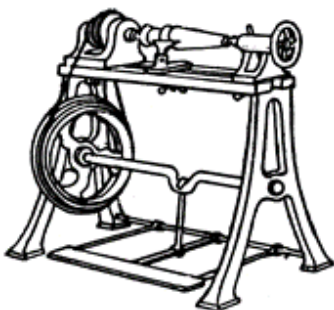
WE HAVE A DATE AND A VENUE FOR OUR SHOW!!!

Minutes: Minutes from last board meeting were accepted

Treasurer's Report: Summary

Major outlays during the past three months include annual room rental and Library "storage" fees (\$440.00 for July 2020 to July 2021), speaker fees, library books and Webex subscription fees.

During the pandemic we spent less on speaker fees and room rental, but we spent money on the 2020 Show which was essentially lost (printing and other promotional fees), and many of our expenses are fixed (insurance, office expenses etc.) We also had additional expenses for the online meeting platform (Webex). We also made the decision to not charge out full membership fee in 2020. As a result, the Guild now has \$4,412.57 in the bank, which is about half of what we had at this time in 2019. Hopefully we can reverse this with a show in the fall and a return to collecting full dues.
