Our presenter is Bob Newton:

Bob Newton is a retired Tech Education Teacher from Sheboygan. Bob has made over 2000 bowls. He has made most of these using a unique machine called a "Ringmaster".

This machine permits you to use a flat piece of lumber, usually $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch thick and cut rings from the stock and fabricate a bowl to your desired height. There is much less waste stock with this method than turning a solid blank.

Bob will explain how this works and show pictures and samples as well. He will also tell you about the ringmaster.
