October Program Review

Our presenter was Michael Doerr, woodworking artist and furniture builder, from Sturgeon Bay. He has made furniture for customers across the country. He detailed his start as a shipwright at the Ferdinand Nimphius' shipyard in 1977, with examples of the techniques needed for ship building.

He later worked with Sam Maloof, learning furniture specific techniques. He has taught in many venues himself, and has devised his own techniques.

He builds from what he calls the “cube” or “box” form, creating major joints at this point, and later shaping legs, etc. to final form. He recommends Festool track saws, and Domino cutters for joints. Also slow setting epoxy for glue up, Turgoll (boiled linseed oil/marine varnish) hand rubbed finish.
